Winemakers comments – Christa Deans

The 2005 Eden Hall Riesling is delicately aromatic displaying enticing freshly cut lemons and limes and a hint of rosey florals. Citrus and subtle musk characters on the palate enhance the crisp acidity adding to the wines length and elegance. A wine of great complexity, delicacy and finesse coming from a vineyard of distinction and showing so clearly the regionality of a truly great Riesling.

Sealed under screw cap to maintain freshness and the delicate aroma's, ensuring optimum quality and controlled maturation.
